CAI Community Counselling Fund & Youth Wellness Grant – Fall Grantee Convening 2025

Event Summary

Date & Time: November 13 & 14, 2025, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm, both days

Location: Sandman Hotel Downtown Vancouver, 180 W Georgia St, Vancouver, BC

Summary: Community Action Initiative (CAI) is hosting a 2-day convening event in Vancouver this fall for current grant recipients of the <u>CAI Community Counselling Fund</u> and the <u>CAI Youth Wellness Grant</u>. Attendees will participate in 2 days of co-learning and sharing with other CAI grantees who also offer low-barrier counselling and/or youth bereavement services.

Attendees: This is a closed event (invite only), with up to 2 representatives per grant recipient. CAI is also inviting some external partners from government, organizations doing work in the mental health and substance use sector, and other funders to join as guests for parts of the event.

Reimbursement Process

CAI can provide travel and accommodation supports at a reasonable cost to participants who have been confirmed to attend the in-person convening event. Please note that reimbursements will only be provided via e-transfer <u>post-event</u>, upon receipt of valid receipts and banking information.

Why is CAI covering travel and accommodation costs for attendees?

Covering travel for all grantees including those in rural and remote locations creates equitable conditions for grantees that would otherwise face high costs to attend an event in downtown Vancouver. Transit Recommendations

• We are requesting that out of town attendees take transit to the convening event once you arrive in Metro Vancouver, in alignment with our policy on reasonable costs. If you have mobility or other accessibility needs that would require a taxi or ride-share, please contact Adejoke to let us know in advance.



• The <u>Sandman Hotel</u> is very transit accessible. It's a 30-minute transit ride directly from YVR airport to Vancouver City Centre station, and an 8-minute walk from the station to the hotel. From the Horseshoe Bay ferry terminal, it's about an hour bus ride directly from the ferry terminal to the nearest bus stop, which is a 3-minute walk away from the hotel. If you will be driving from YVR Airport, the hotel is 30 minutes away and parking is on-site at the hotel.

When can I book my travel?

You can book travel anytime after receiving a confirmation email from Zavi or Adrienne regarding your RSVP, up to the cut-off date of September 26, 2025 for flights and October 24, 2025 for ferries. Bookings made after this date will not be reimbursed.

What if I cannot cover the up-front costs of booking?

Please get in touch with Adejoke Adeyemi and CAI will cover your costs directly.

Can I leave early or arrive late?

A lot of time, effort and resources has gone into organizing this event, and based on past experiences, late arrivals and early departures can be disruptive. We want everyone to have the best experience possible and to honour the contributions of our speakers and presenters, so we typically don't make exceptions for those who plan to arrive late or leave early.

Once an RSVP is approved, we ask attendees to commit to the full schedule of the convening. If circumstances change, we appreciate timely communication so we can offer the spot to someone on the waitlist. If you're unable to attend the full two days, we encourage you to consider sending another representative in your place.
